Class 1) 50 cm, Mini Jumping, individual and team entries.

Teams of 4 with 3 to count. Single phase, all fences 50cm.

Class 2) 60cm, single phase, 3 jumps of 65cm in the timed section. Open to individuals and teams of 4 with 3 to count.

Class 3) 70cm, single phase, fences 75cm in the timed section.

Class 4) PC 80cm, Barrier Animal Health Spring Festival Qualifier. Single Phase.

Open to individuals and teams of 3 with all to count.

All horses/ponies must be vaccinated as per Pony Club rules.
