

Rules & conditions of entry

- 1. The Show will be run under The Pony Club Eventing Rules 2024 and The Pony Club Arena Eventing Rules, all of which are available on www.pcuk.org
- 2. Riders must be current members of the Pony Club.
- 3. Riders cannot compete in more than two classes per day. Horses/ponies cannot compete more than once in each class or in more than two classes on the day.
- 4. Vaccinations Pony Club rules on vaccinations will apply see biosecurity policy on https://pcuk.org/about-us/policies/. Random checks may be carried out.
- 5. Cross Country compliant XC kit and Saddlery should be worn. The Pony Club Saddlery and Dress rules apply.
- 6. The Judges' and Organisers' decision is final.
- 7. All classes are open to horses and ponies of any height.
- 8. No horses are to be left tied to the outside of a lorry / trailer.
- 9. Dogs are allowed on site but must be kept on a lead. Any dog mess must be cleared up.
- 10. The Show organisers reserve the right to cancel any class with less than 5 entries.
- 11. Withdrawals received after closing date (13 October) will not be refunded. Withdrawals received on/before 13 October will be refunded the entry fee less a booking fee.
- 12. If the event is cancelled for any reason entry fees will be refunded less an administration fee of up to £5.
- 13. Please note that if you do not adhere to the rules you may be asked to leave the site even if you have not yet competed.
- 14. If you would like to edit your horse or rider details before the closing date of the event please login to your Horse Events account and edit your booking under the 'MY BOOKING' Tab. If you would like to change the class please email info@horse-events.co.uk and if there is space available they will do this for you.
