- 3 The age of any competitor is as of the day of the show.
- 4 The judges reserve the right to disqualify any rider whom they consider to be under-horsed or unethical in any way.
- 5 In any dispute as to the height of a horse/ pony a Height Certificate will be required. Similarly in a dispute as to a rider's age, a Birth Certificate will be required.
- 6 All classes may be limited at the discretion of the organisers.
- 7 Entry fees cannot be refunded except on production of a medical or veterinary certificate.
- 8 The organisers are not responsible for any negligence, loss or damage to persons, animals, vehicles or property no matter how caused. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the organisers against any legal action arising from such an incident.
- 9 Horses and ponies under 4 years may only be shown in hand (age taken from 1st May 2025).
- 10 Any competitor who falls in a jumping class will be eliminated and must report to the paramedics.
- 11 All entrants must have third party insurance.


