SHOW JUMPING

Open to any teams or individuals (under 25 years) – including non-members. Only Area 3 Pony Club members will qualify for the Junior Series Classes. Advance entries only – closing date Tuesday 17th September 2024 unless classes full before this date. Additional class entries available on day if time allows. <u>All classes are single phase with a timed section</u>.

<u>Class 1:</u> Individual – Cross poles (40cms max) (one round to include timed section). <u>Lead reins allowed</u>.

Class 2: Individual – 50cms max (one round to include timed section). Lead reins allowed.

<u>AREA 3 JUNIOR SERIES</u> – classes 3,4 and 5 are qualifiers for the Final of the Junior Series. The top 2 teams and 4 individuals in each class will qualify. Qualification will pass down the line if already qualified in a team or as an individual. Age as at 1st January 2024.

OPEN CLASSES

Competitors may only enter classes 3A and 4A if they are too old to enter the corresponding class for that height. For example, a competitor may <u>not</u> enter class 3 AND class 3A

<u>Class 3:</u> Junior Series -10 yrs and under – 60cm (one round to include timed section).

<u>Class 3A:</u> OPEN (11 yrs and over NO TEAM COMPETITION) - 60cms max (one round to include timed section).

<u>Class 4:</u> Junior Series -12 yrs and under – 70cm (one round to include timed section).

Class 4A: OPEN (13 yrs and over NO TEAM COMPETITION) – 70cm (one round to include timed section).

<u>Class 5:</u> Junior Series -12 yrs and under – 80cm (one round to include timed section).

Teams for the Junior Series may be of 3 or 4 members but all team members will also be judged as individuals. Best 3 scores to count.

Class 6: Individual - 80cm

Class 7: Individual - 90cm

DRESSAGE

Class 8: Intro B (British Dressage Intro B - 2009) - Lead Rein Allowed

Class 9: Prelim 7 (BD Prelim 7 - 2002)

Class 10: Novice 24 (BB Novice 24 - 2010)

Class 11: PC 70 (Riders 13year and under)

Class 12: PC 80 (Open)

Class 13: Pick Your Own (any BD Intro, Prelim or Novice) – Please state test in notes/comments on entry.

For all dressage classes, whips of any length may be carried and all tests can be commanded

Entry fee: £12 per competitor for Class 1, 2 & 8. All other classes £15 per competitor per class. Advance online entries only. Closing date for entries Tuesday 17th September 2024. Times will be posted on the www.horse-events.co.uk website from 6pm on Thursday 19th September 2024.

Class 1 & 2 Rosettes to 6th place subject to entries Classes 3 -5 Rosettes to 4th place for teams and individuals if sufficient entries received. Classes 6 & 7 Rosettes to 6th place subject to entries

Combinations may only jump once for each team in each class. Horses/ponies may only compete in a maximum of 3 consecutive classes.

This competition is run under Pony Club rules 2024. No jewellery is allowed including sleepers. Hats to be tagged as to the required PC standard and must be fastened and worn at all times when mounted. No spurs are allowed in classes 1 and 2 and in other classes with DC's permission only. Jackets and ties or stocks must be worn hair must either be above the collar or securely contained in a hairnet.

NO DOGS ALLOWED. HOT & COLD REFRESHMENTS WILL BE AVAILABLE ALL DAY
