- Shooting Please ensure all competitors comply with firearms regulations.
 It is a condition of entry that all competitors are capable of handling a gun correctly and that they and their loaders have had adequate training in safety on the firing range. Pistols must remain boxed at all times. They may only be unboxed at the firing point on the instruction of the range steward.
 You are reminded of the rules regarding dress. PLEASE INDICATE ON THE ENTRY IF THE COMPETITOR IS LEFT-HANDED.
- Running Competitors will be started 'en mass' depending on weather conditions, this phase may be on a mixed surface.
- Swimming Class 1 buoyancy aids will be allowed and there will be no penalty. PLEASE INDICATE ON THE ENTRY FORM IF THE COMPETITOR IS USING AN AID AS OUTSIDE LANE WILL BE REQUIRED.

There is limited phone reception at the venue, please ensure you have recorded your times prior to the start.
