CLASSES (entry fees include First Aid):

Class 1: Complete Novice Pairs (fences approx. 65-70cm). Start 9:30am.

Entry Fee: £30 OS&BPC members per pair, £34 non-members per pair

Class 2: Complete Novice Individual (fences approx. 65-70cm)

Entry Fee: £16 OS&BPC members, £19 non-members

Class 3: Novice Pairs (fences approx. 80cm)

Entry Fee: £32 OS&BPC members per pair, £38 non-members per pair

Class 4: Novice Individual (fences approx. 80cm)

Entry Fee: £20 OS&BPC members, £24 non-members

Class 5: Intermediate Individual (fences approx. 90cm)

Entry Fee: £20 OS&BPC members, £24 non-members

Rosettes to 8th place in each class. Prize giving will take place at the end of each class. Rosettes must be collected on the day – they will not be posted out.

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- No entry fees will be refunded without a doctors' or veterinary certificate.
- In the event of cancellation of this event, entries will be refunded less a £5 admin fee.
- All entries are subject to a non-refundable booking fee which will be stated online on a per class basis
- All equines must be accompanied by a valid passport with a valid annual fu vaccination.
- Hard Hats conforming to PC/BE Standards MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES with the chin straps done up when mounted. No fixed peaks.
- Body Protectors conforming to PC/BE Standards MUST BE WORN WHEN JUMPING BETA 2018.
- Competitors using body protectors that require a key MUST lodge that key with the Event Secretary on the day
- If Air Jackets are worn, they MUST be worn over a body protector conforming to the above standards.
- Medical Armbands MUST BE WORN IF COMPETING ALONE
- Hair must be tied back securely above the shoulders in a safe manner to avoid the risk of hair being caught and to prevent scalp injuries. Hair must not obscure the competitor's number. The wearing of jewellery is not recommended and if worn is entirely the responsibility of the rider or their parent/guardian. Dangling necklaces, bracelets and piercings are not allowed due to the risk of them being caught.
- No stopwatches, drones, earpieces or headcams are allowed. Competitors must proceed directly from the final fence to the finish.

- The winner of each class will be the horse and rider with the least number of jumping faults nearest to the bogey time.
- Three refusals at one fence or cumulative four refusals around the course will result in elimination. Competitors may continue at discretion of Fence Judge.
- Excessive use of spurs or whips may result in heavy penalties and/or elimination
- No horse/pony to be ridden more than once in each class
- Any competitor in difficulty at a fence must make way for a following competitor who is about to overtake.
- The decision of the Judges and Stewards are final.
- No unattended horses/ponies to be left tied to the outside of lorries/trailers.
- Dogs must be kept on short leads and you must clear up after them.
