## Rules and Conditions

All horses/ponies must be a minimum of 5 years old.

No Stallions

- Vaccination must be up to date
- **Competition will be run under Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2024**
- **• THE JUDGE'S DECISION IS FINAL**
- Teams to consist of 3 or 4 riders. Best 3 scores count.
- Team members will also be judged as individuals
- **Competitor numbers MUST be visible at all times whilst mounted.**
- **SPURS** worn anywhere on the showground must comply with PC Show Jumping Rules. • **NO SPURS** in Classes 1 to 3.
- **HATS** Must be PC Tagged, with a pink tag, **before** the competition or being worn in the collecting ring. Compliant hats can be tagged by the secretary.
- There will be a Tack Inspection at the Warm Up arena.
- Horses/ponies must not be left unattended tied up outside a vehicle.
- Children should not jump in the collecting ring without an accompanying adult.
- If the Show is cancelled due to circumstances beyond our control, entry fees will be refunded. Any refund will be subject to an administration fee.

Health & Safety Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.
