No videoing in the arena when doing equipment etc.

So, if you have a Novice/safe pony you wish to get out for a bit of experience please do, and state on the entry form.

No Dogs Allowed. All classes will be run under Pony Club Mounted Games rules 2024/25.

Hats must comply with the current Pony Club standards and be appropriately tagged. **Please provide your own hat bands. There may be some available to borrow but we would ask for a donation to The Air Ambulance.**

No jewellery/hoodies to be worn.

No horse or pony shall be left unattended or tied to a trailer/horse box unless supervised by a responsible person. **Clear up all rubbish, droppings, dropped hay from around your vehicle either in the lorry park or trailer park.**

All entries are subject to a non-refundable booking fee which will be stated online on a per class basis.
